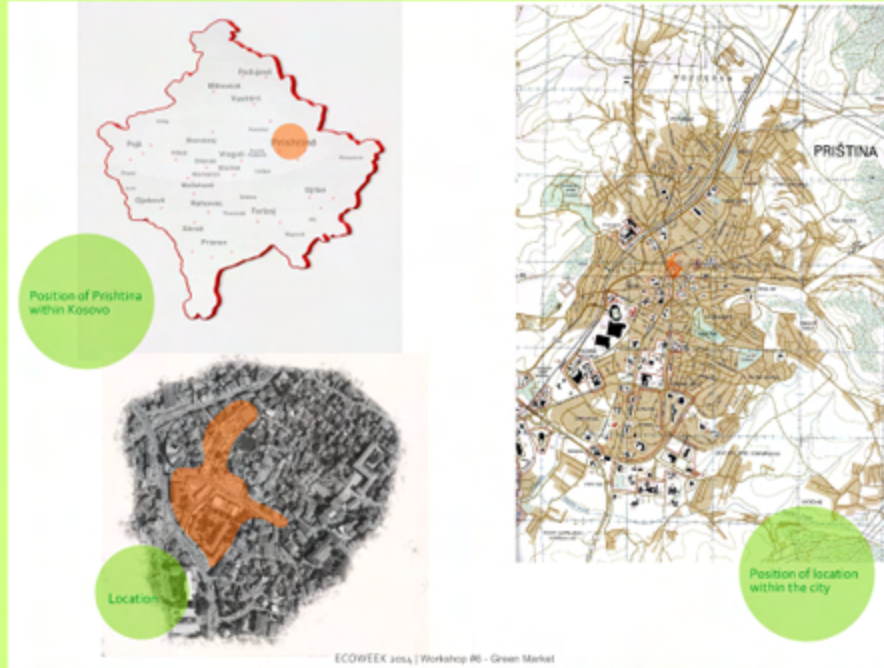

GREEN MARKET
History:
Market stalls were built during the 1950s and 1960s, mainly from brick and concrete. They were designed to be functional and durable, reflecting the socialist aesthetic of the time. 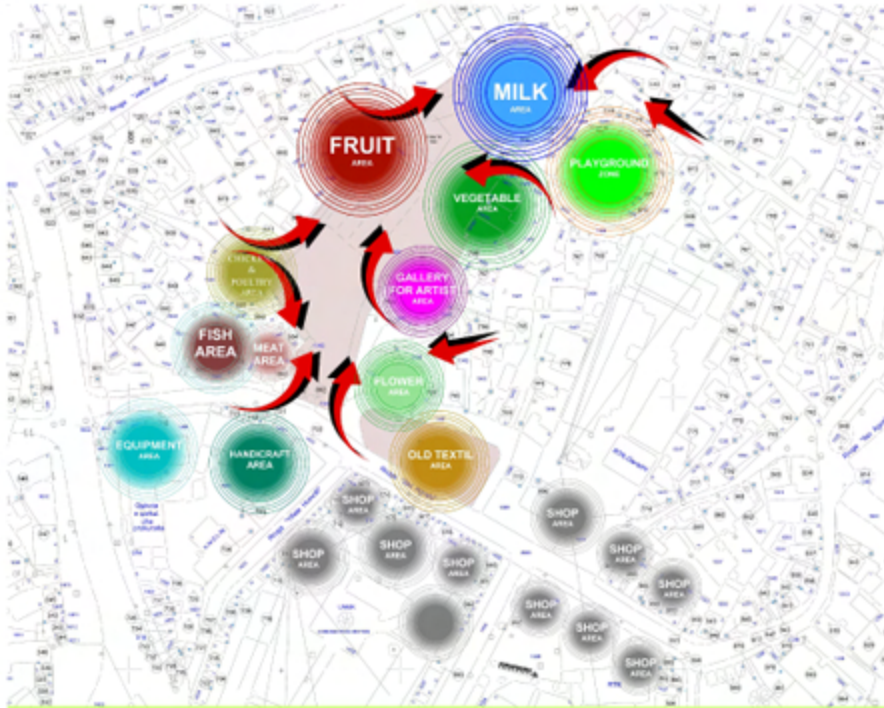
THE EXISTING MARKET

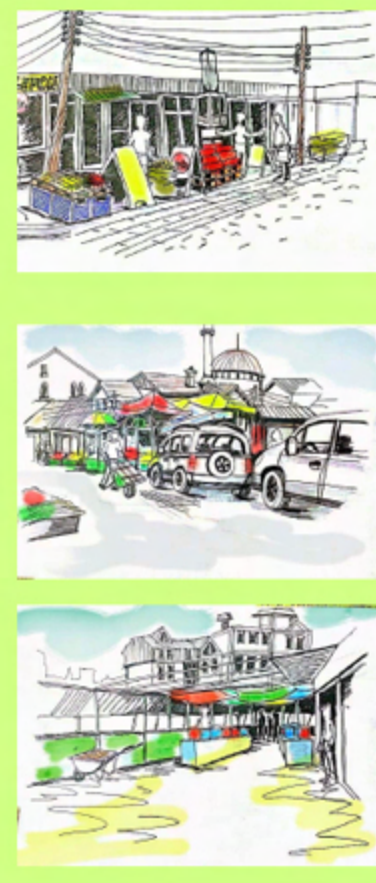
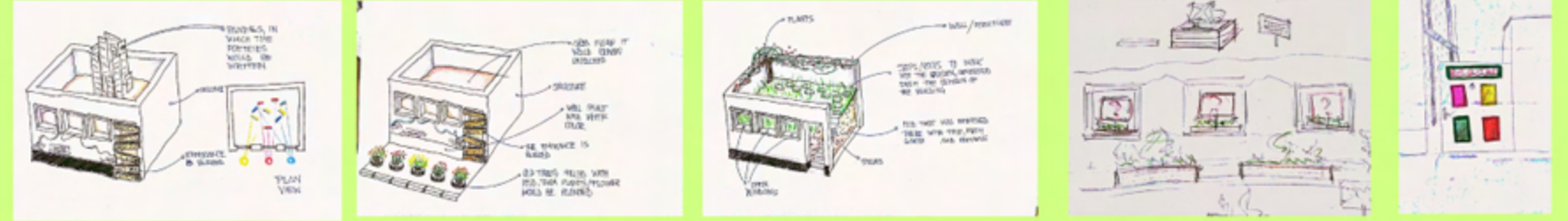


The idea was to remove the green market from the street and to relocate at the original place/area.

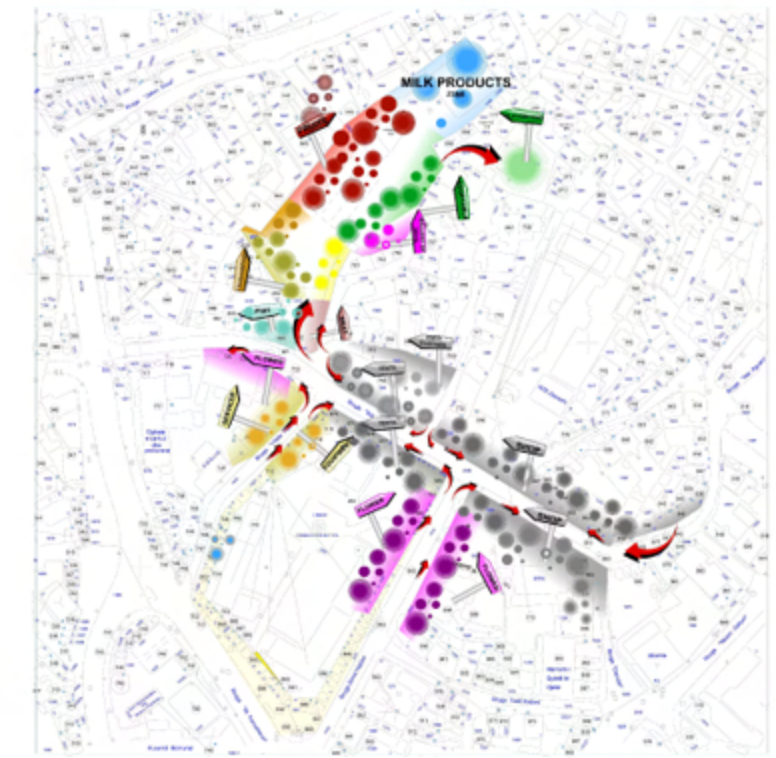

PROPOSED NEW MARKET ZONING

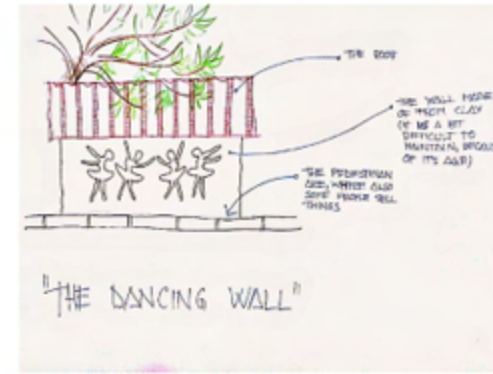
