

## Artemida

### *A few words*

The site is located in Artemida suburb, Alkyonos and A.D. Fragou Street. Artemida (Greek: Αρτέμιδα, older name Loutsa, Greek: Λούτσα) is a suburban town in east Attica, approximately 25 km east of Athens. Artemida is known for its beach stretching over most of the east coast, as well as for hotels, bars, restaurants and local taverns. In the past, Artemida was mainly defined as a not permanent place for living, just for holidays. However, in due time, as city of Athens is developing, more and more people choose Artemida as a permanent place to live. The town is accessible by bus.

As for the site, it has three open space facades which offer to it a marvelous view to the sea and green planted space. The neighborhood has 2 to 5 floor buildings and most of them are recently erected.
