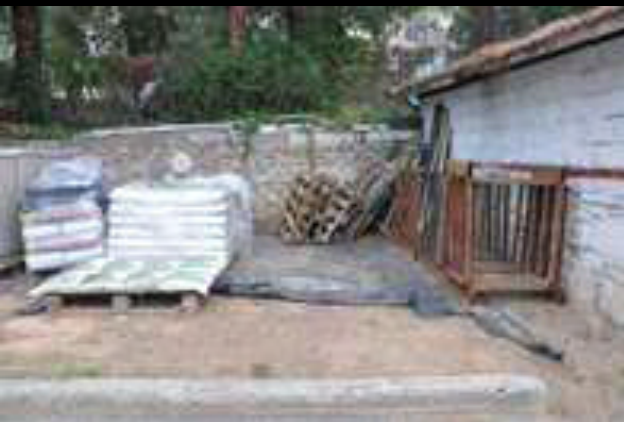

we cleaned up the existing plantation and rocks. We used these grass and stones for filling up the holes in the garden





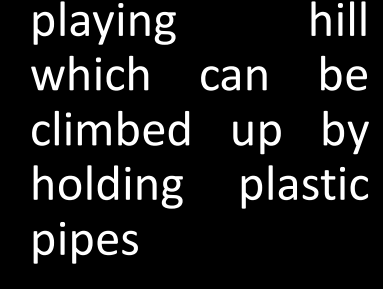

sitting-playing units from the tires

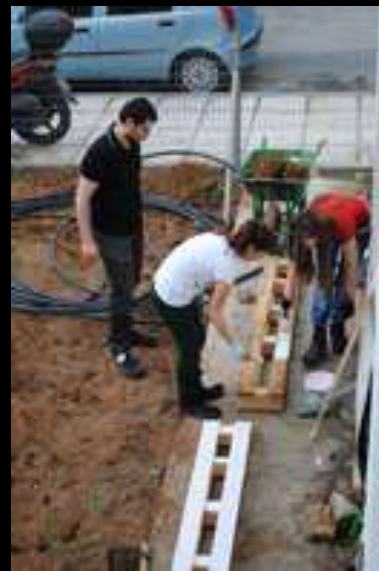


playing hill which can be climbed up by holding plastic pipes
